Clinic-Call Configuration Questions

Each time a new system is planned there are some basic configuration questions that need to be answered. The following is the basic starting point for all Medical Office Building Clinics:

1.	Home many Exam Rooms are there?	
2.	How many Providers?	
	(This determines the number of Buttons / Colors)	
3.	Do all providers cover all exam rooms?	
	(The answer to this is almost always "Yes". However this is seldom the truth. In most cases Exam Rooms are tied to procedures, which mean to a skill set and tools, which limits the number of providers. Explore this and you will probably find that each provider covers no more than 4 rooms and there are no more than 3 providers or care levels per room.)	
4.	Do they want "Provider Call for Assistance"? (Emergency Call)	
5.	Do they want Corridor Lights?	
	(Are the corridors long and narrow requiring wide viewing angle Corridor Lights.)	
6.	Do any of the Exam Rooms require special features such as Dilation Timer?	
7.	Do they want "Doctor Follow"? (Next Patient feature)	
8.	How many Annunciation locations for the same rooms?	
	(Nurses Stations, Receptionist, Private Offices, Labs, Etc.)	
9.	Can some of the areas in number "4" above use a Zone Light for annunciation?	
10	.Do Zone Lights need "TONE"?	
11	.Do any Annunciator locations need "Patient Arrival"?	
12	Do they have any special Procedure Rooms with special needs?	
13	.Do they have any Public Rest Rooms? (Pull Stations)	
14	.Do they want Integrated Messaging and Reporting?	
	(Text Messaging, Digital Signage, Management Reporting)
